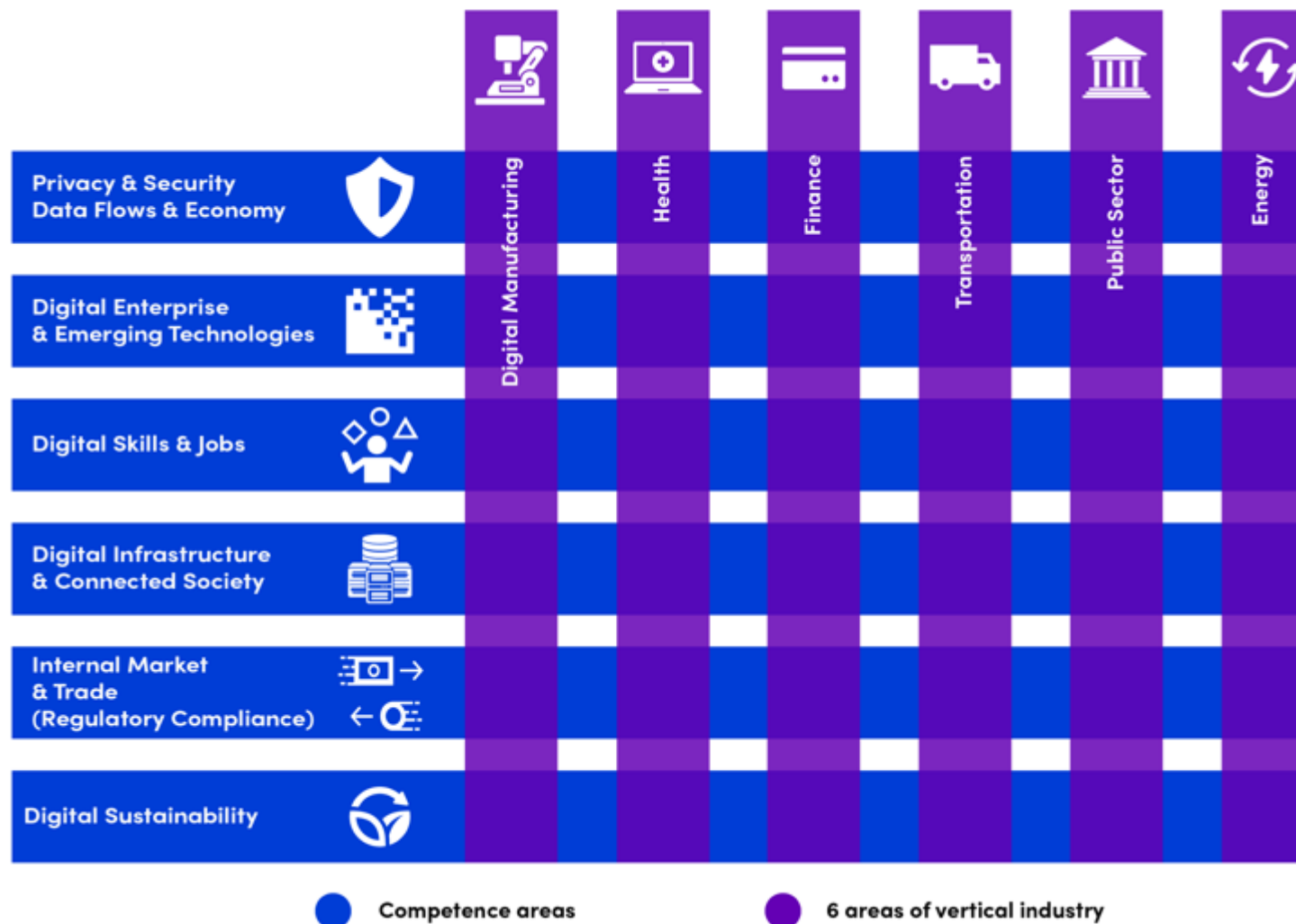

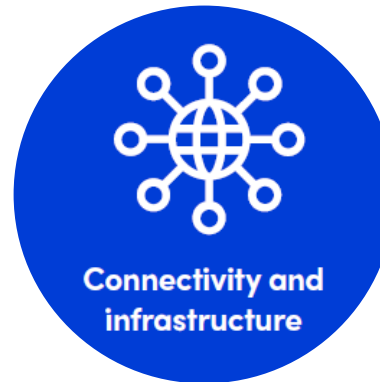

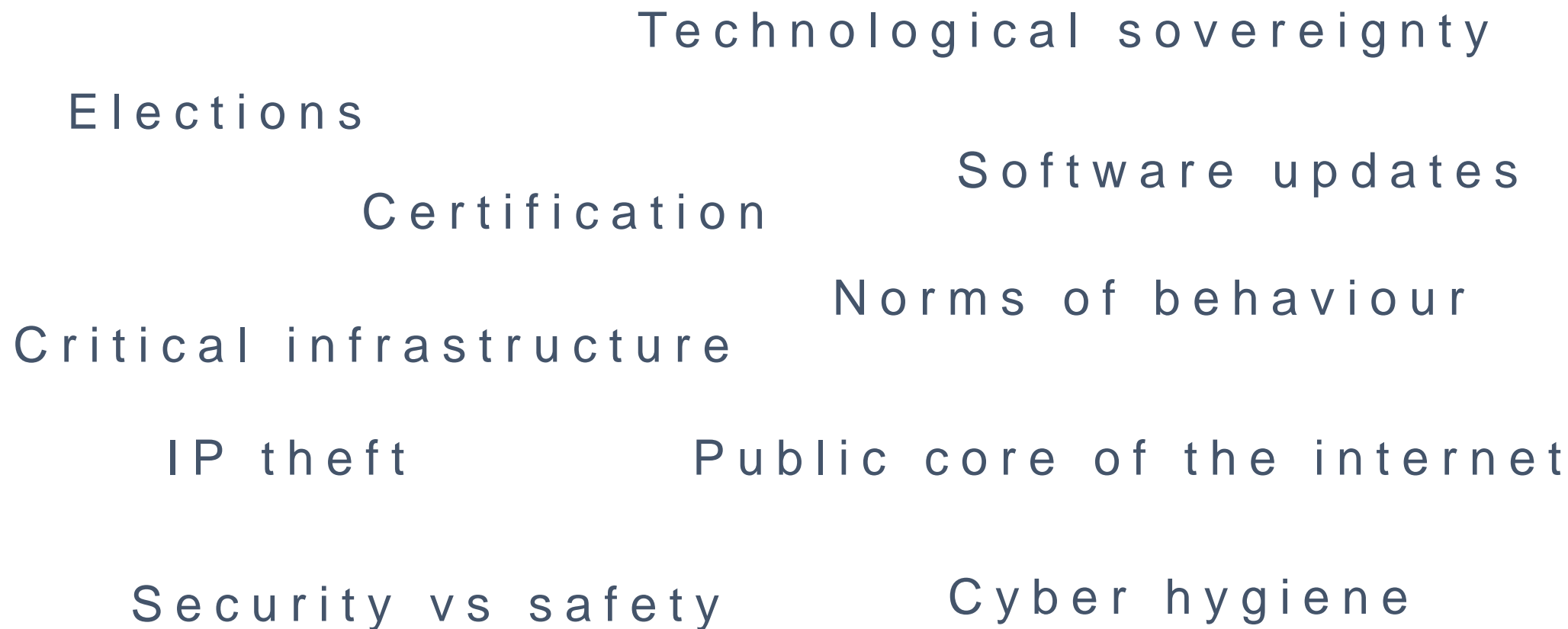


The speeding train of cybersecurity in the EU

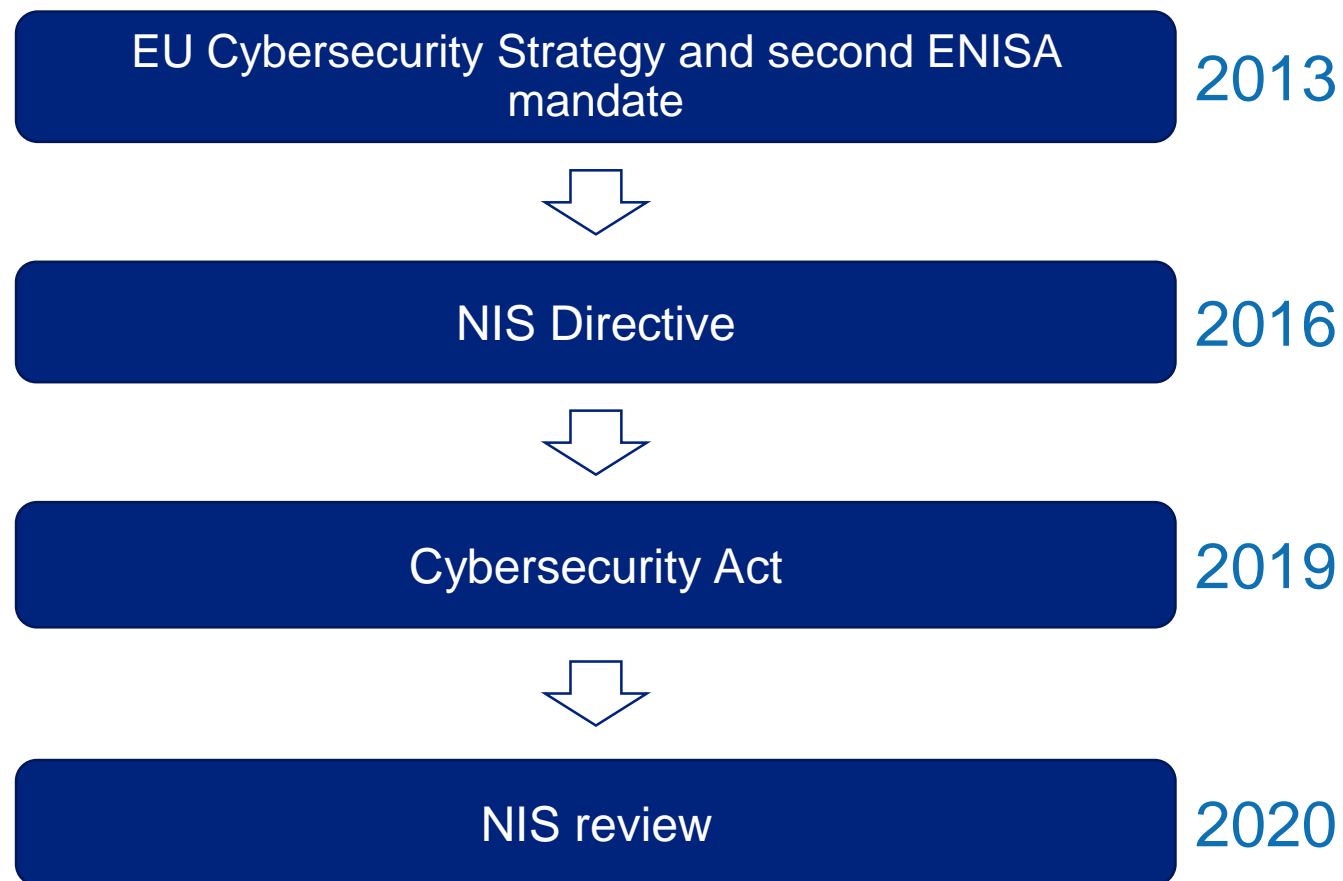

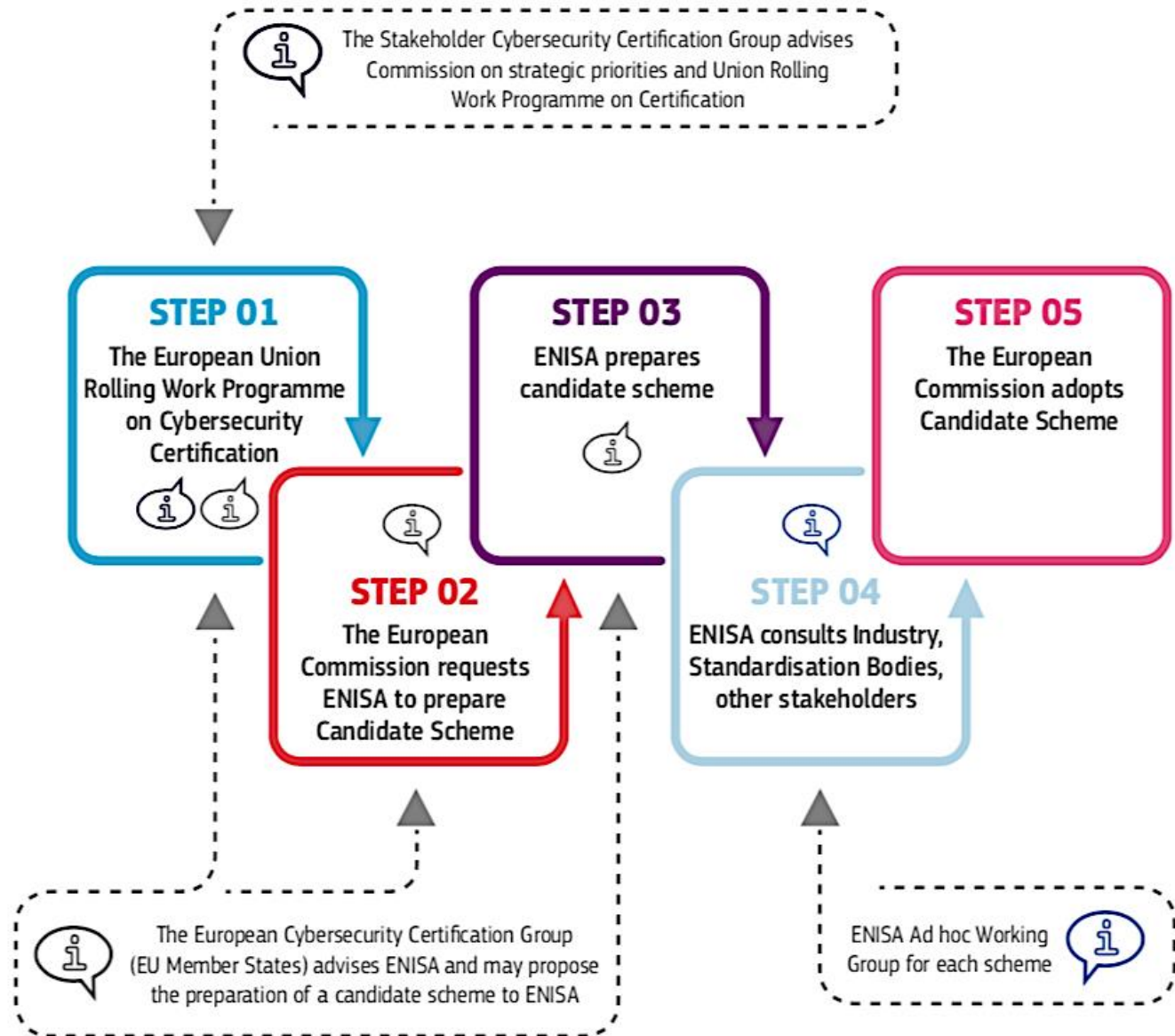

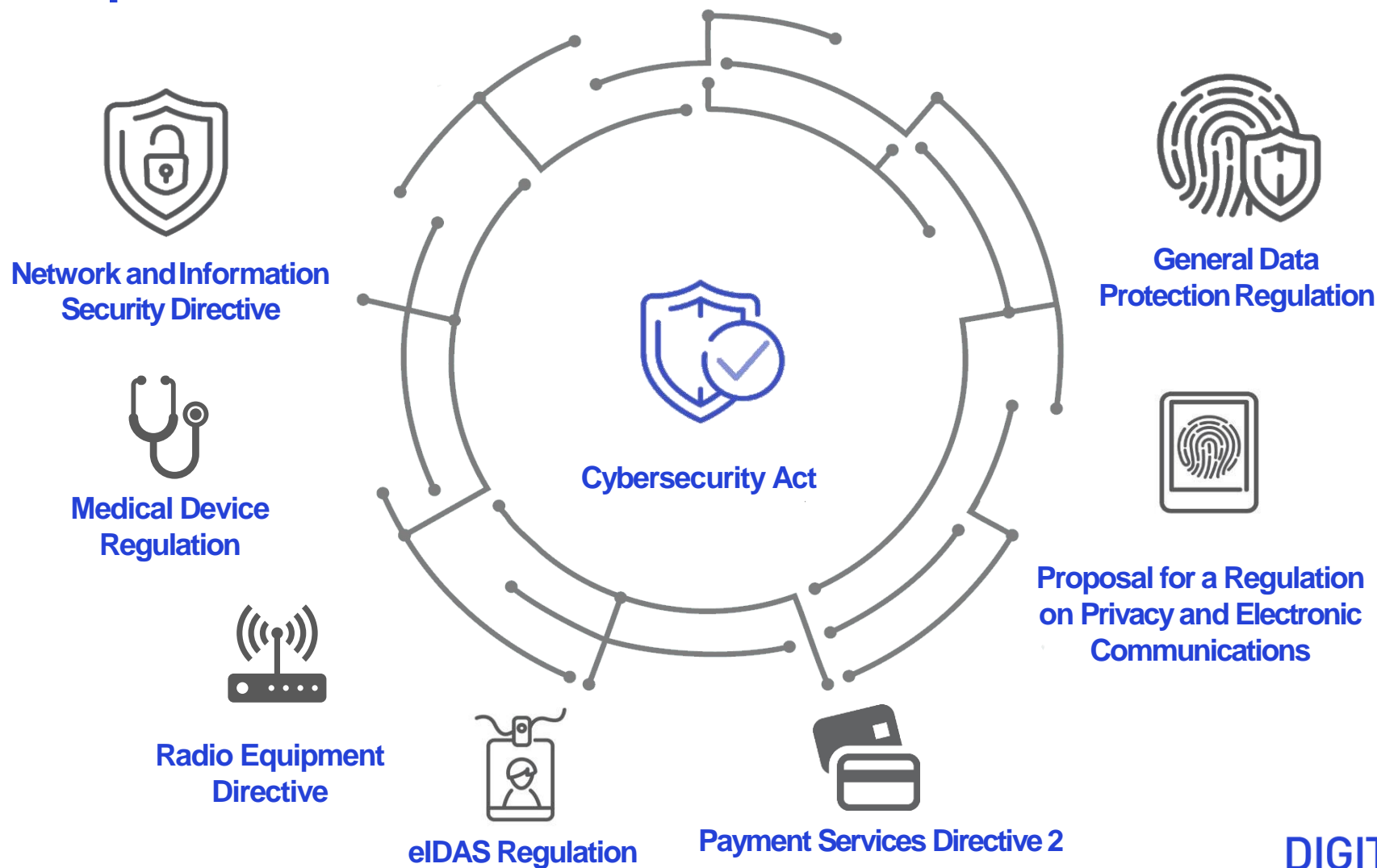
