

- Budapest Convention on Cybercrime (2001)
 - National Criminal Code (Luxembourg)

CYBERCRIMES

- 1) Offences related to confidentiality, integrity and availability of computer systems;
- 2) Content-offences: general criminal offences committed by use of a computer or an electronic device

- Fraudulent access or maintenance in an automated data processing system (509-1)
- Obstruction of the operation of an automated data processing system (509-2)
- Entry, alteration or modification of data (509-3)

- Interception of data during non-public transmissions (509-3)
- Access, maintenance, obstruction, alteration of an automated data processing system with transfer of money or monetary value (509-4)

- Production, sale, acquisition, possession, import, distribution or made available of a computer device intended to commit one of the offenses referred to in Articles 509-1 to 509-4; or any electronic key allowing access, regardless of the rights of others, to all or part of an automated data processing or transmission system (509-5)

- Attempt (509-6)

- Criminal association for the same offenses (509-7)

- Breach of confidentiality of correspondence or of private life (art. 460)
- Counterfeit and theft of electronic keys (artt. 488 and 461q)
- Fraud (art. 496)
- Disclosure of business or trade secrets (309)
